On **June 6**, 1944, at the height of World War II, the Allied troops landed on the beaches of Normandy to fight the German troops in what became known as D-Day. Operation Neptune, as it was formally designated at the time, started the effort to liberate France from German occupation. It was the largest invasion by sea in history. American, British, and Canadian forces played a big part in the planning and execution of the operation.

On **June 14** all across the United States, people commemorate Flag Day. This day celebrates the birthday of the United States flag, which was first adopted on June 14, 1777. This day also coincides with the U.S. Army's Birthday, founded on June 14, 1775.

Korean War

The Korean War started on **June 25, 1950**, when North Korea's army invaded South Korea. This was considered the first military strike of the Cold War. The war lasted from June 25, 1950, to July 27, 1953. The United States joined the war in July, backing South Korea, in another effort in America's fight against the propagation of communism.
