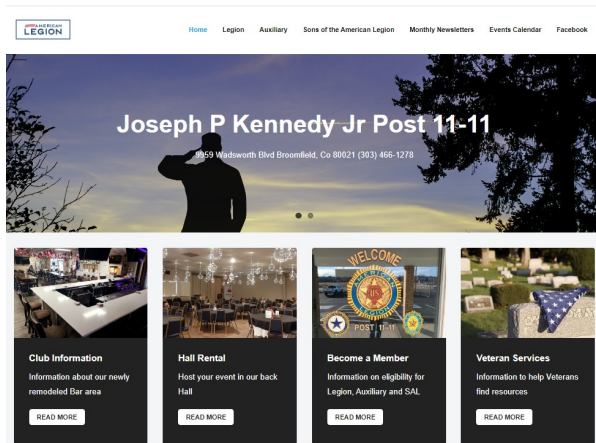

No Outside Food when food is being served.

No Outside Drinks, including water can be brought into the Post at any time.
