Happy New Month to all our members. Here is something new for veterans and their families. Beginning June 10th, 2024, families of deceased veterans can apply to receive a Commemorative plaque or Walnut Urn from the C=VA if they do not want to inter their loved ones in a VA National Cemetery or receive a Government issued head stone, marker or medallion for placement in any ceremony. They must fill out a VA Form 40-1330 UP claim for a Commemorative Walnut Urn or Plaque for Veterans. For more information, please contact your post Service Officer:
