Please plan to attend the next Legion Meeting on Tuesday, October 8, 2024.

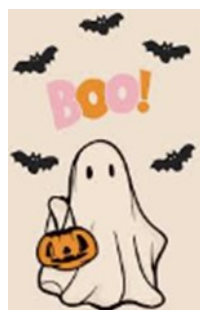
We will be voting on an amendment to the By Laws, which would require anyone who desires to run for Legion Commander must have attended 60% on the Legion Membership meetings in the prior year.
